Description: International House is a program and residential center located in the southeast foothills of the Berkeley campus, conveniently located near Boalt Hall Law School and the Haas Business School and is within walking distance of the central campus, recreational facilities, and commercial areas of Berkeley. International House provides a variety of facilities for work and recreation. The Resident Computer Center provides both Macintosh and IBM compatible computers, printers, a variety of updated software and access to the campus network for e-mail. For entertainment, the House has 3 television areas, a game room, pianos, ping pong tables, and a variety of sports equipment. Other on-site amenities include laundry facilities, a resident fax machine and a small store where residents can buy souvenirs and personal necessities. During the summer months, I-House sponsors a variety of programs and excursions designed to enhance the multicultural purpose of this unique residential community. International House offers single and double room accommodations. Rooms are completely furnished with beds, dressers, desks, desk lamps and chairs. Meals are served in our dining hall which serves breakfast, lunch and dinner Monday through Friday and brunch and dinner on the weekends.

Description: The BSC is a non-profit, low-cost living group owned and operated by students. With 17 group living houses and three apartment complexes in the immediate campus area, the Co-op accommodates 1,200 students and offers a unique opportunity to meet others, participate in group decision-making, and develop self-responsibility. During the summer, all houses except one are co-ed, and two houses are reserved for graduate and re-entry students. Three houses had food service and all the rest of the houses have kitchen facilities. In addition to paying rent, all members work a few hours a week. Admission is first-come, first-served.
