

A3C – Ageing, Climate Change and Citizenship

Call

Opportunity for ~25 students – EUGLOH Alliance

15th to 17th of July 2020

Scope

The inter-university Alliance EUGLOH – *European University for Global Health* (<https://www.eugloh.eu/>), a pilot initiative funded by the European Commission, within the Erasmus+ Program, is composed by 5 European Universities: University of Paris-Saclay (France), Ludwig-Maximilians-University München (Germany), Lund University (Sweden), University of Szeged (Hungary) and University of Porto (Portugal).

This Alliance aims at stimulating cooperation on a variety of areas linked to Global Health (digital health, public health and well-being, environmental protection and food safety).

Description of the activity

A3C – Ageing, Climate Change and Citizenship aims at promoting discussion, in groups, among Master and PhD students, gathering the 5 EUGLOH partners on innovative solutions for societal issues, such as Ageing, Climate Change and Citizenship, in line with the 2030 agenda and the Sustainable Development Goals. During this 3-day online workshop, Master and PhD students will be able to discuss and share creative ideas and methodologies, and stimulate innovation, in relation to the interconnections of these topics and their relevance to the response to present economic, social and environmental challenges. Through hands-on methodologies, case-studies combined with a personal development component, such as group dynamics, participants will anticipate future professional settings in an international and interdisciplinary environment and develop team spirit, creative and critical thinking, leadership and communication skills.

Activity Structure

This activity will take place between the 15th and the 17th of July 2020 and it will have a previous introductory session on the 8th of July, between 13h00 and 15h00 CET. The programme will be held in English and fully online.

The training will be composed of:

- 24 hours synchronous training;
- 57 hours autonomous work.

Phases:

The 3-day intensive course will be preceded by a 2-hour session to introduce participants to the activity objectives and to prepare them with the reading materials for individual work. Therefore, it is composed of the following phases:

- 8th to the 14th of July – preparatory phase;
- 15th to the 17th of July – 3-day intensive workshop.

Selection criteria

The University of Porto will select approx. 25 (twenty-five) students.

For selection purposes, the following criteria will be applied:

- to be enrolled as a student of the University of Porto in the 2nd or 3rd study cycles (MA/PhD) (all study areas are eligible);
- min. language level, assessed in the motivation section on the application form;
- motivation for participation;
- curriculum vitae and academic path;
- innovative dissertation/thesis theme.

Preferable conditions

- Balance among participants in terms of gender and study areas shall be considered.

Work Language

Considering the transnational nature of the activity, the working language will be English. It is essential that students have knowledge of the language (advised minimum level B2/C1; please refer to the self-assessment grid (levels of proficiency), as described in the [Common European Framework of Reference for Languages](#) (CEFR)).

Certification

ECTS credits to be confirmed; Certification of attendance.

Funding

No tuition fees.

Application Procedures

Candidates willing to participate must complete the online form, available at: <https://www.eugloh.eu/events/a3c-ageing-climate-change-and-citizenship>, until the 2nd of July and attach the following proposal documents:

- Curriculum vitae.

Selection of candidates will be made by a committee, composed by members of the EUGLOH Alliance at the University of Porto.

Evaluation and selection process

A selection committee composed by the following elements will evaluate the submitted/eligible applications:

- Professor Teresa Seixas, Faculty of Sciences of the U.Porto;
- Professor Sandra Torres, Faculty of Psychology and Education Science;
- Susana Neves, EUGLOH WP4 officer at U.Porto.

The evaluation of applications will consider the above-mentioned criteria. In case of withdrawal, the University of Porto will select candidates from the reserve list.

Selection results will be communicated to all candidates (selected or not), via e-mail. For transparency purposes, the selection minutes are made public.
